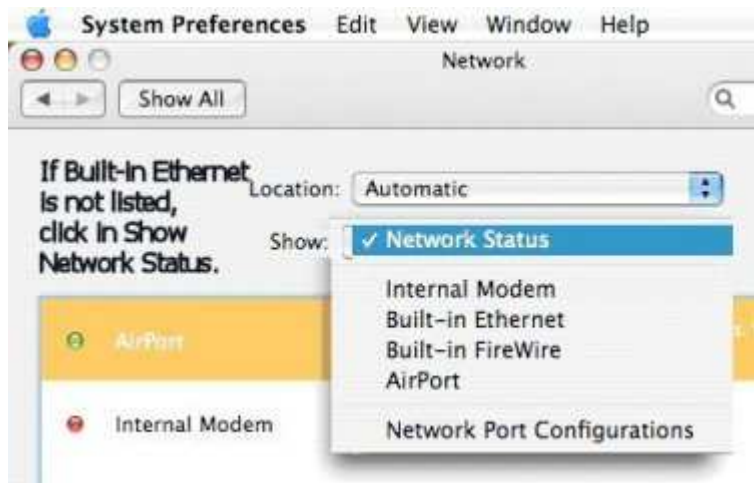


From the Apple menu, select System Preferences. The System Preferences window will appear. Click on the Network icon. The Network preferences will be revealed.



NOTE: If the settings appear to be all grayed out, you will need to authorize yourself as an Administrator

Settings for Macintosh OS X 10.3 & 10.4



Click on the Configure button at the bottom of the page.

- Select **Built-in Ethernet** in the **Show:** drop down menu.
- In the **TCP/IP** section, select **Using DHCP** in the **Configure:** drop down menu.



Make sure there are no proxies enabled for the MAC user!

Once the "Network" preference panel is displayed,

- select your connection method and click the "Configure..." button,
- click on the "Proxies" tab,
- make sure all of them are unchecked
- click the "Apply Now" button,
- and quit "System Preferences".
