Course Requirements:

1. Complete one full year of Hebrew in 14 weeks (7 weeks for each semester). The courses will follow Seow's order, Chapters 1-30)
2. Two **examinations** will be given (**Mid-Term** and **Final**) for each course.
3. A quiz will be given covering each chapter.
4. Ability to read the Hebrew Bible will develop almost immediately; the remainder of the two semesters will be spent increasing in competence in reading, understanding, and proclaiming the message of **BOTH** Testaments with greater clarity and power.
