#### Course Requirements:

1. **Weekly engagement** and **active contribution** to peer discussions
2. **List 1 required reading** and **integrative reflection**: write a 10-page integrative reflective paper analyzing, synthesizing, and applying to ministry context
3. **List 2 required reading** and **concept mapping**: diagram (via illustration) emerging frameworks and concepts from select readings, demonstrating linkage across disciplines/topics with written explanation (10-pages), accompanied by a 10–12-minute class presentation
4. **Reflection essays**: 2-page reflection essay on each presentation/interview by course guest speakers (3-5 presentations)
5. **Capstone Project**: create a global model of best practices of Pentecost-shaped leaders (15-pages)
